Our clubs provision is constantly evolving as we seek fresh and inspiring ways to extend and enrich children's learning and respond dynamically to their interests.

At the heart of our ambition for Blackheath Prep is our commitment to providing the very best for all children to enjoy and achieve. This includes having the widest possible range of opportunities both within and beyond the curriculum. We offer extra-curricular opportunities through various types of provision delivered by school staff, external providers and independent clubs, all with a view to increasing the range of experiences that children have, enabling them to make informed choices for adult life. Activities are designed to be fun and cater for a wide variety of interests.

We want to offer the scope for each and every child to find a passion, develop a talent, spark an interest or simply find pleasure in doing an activity with others. After-school clubs are a fantastic way of achieving this and we are excited to offer a wide range of clubs. This booklet outlines all of the clubs we have available, from singing and drama, to netball, animation, football and Munchkins multi-sports, reading and musical composition.

Some internal clubs are heavily oversubscribed every term and children may be placed on a waiting list for these clubs. Whilst every effort is made to ensure that children are able to enjoy their choice of clubs, this is not always possible.

Clubs may be cancelled if there are not enough participants.

We hope you will take time to explore what is on offer and encourage your child to try something new or continue taking part in a firm favourite.

We will be using the online SchoolCloud booking system for all internal clubs. External club providers have various means of booking which are detailed in this booklet.

All club bookings will open on **Wednesday 13 December 8pm** and close **Wednesday 3 January 8pm**.

Please note that the clubs run by outside agencies require direct booking and payment to secure your place. The charge for all internal clubs run by staff will be added to your Spring Term Fee invoice. Occasionally, fixtures and other events will mean that children may miss a club and in these circumstances, **we regret that we are unable to provide a refund.** The PE Department will make every effort to schedule fixtures on Games afternoons to minimise disruption to after-school activities so please bear this in mind when booking your clubs.

The school's Spring term calendar will be available on My School Portal. If you feel that too many sessions of a club are likely to be missed due to other events, you have the option to change or cancel your bookings at the start of the Spring Term. No changes will be accepted once the clubs programme has commenced on **Monday 15 January 2024.**

Over the term, we will discuss the works of Cubist, Dadaist and Surrealist artists and develop three key pieces - exploring dreams through collage, making a dream house and constructing a 3D mobile. The IDTA and ISTD are recognized awarding organisations of the CDMT (Council of Dance, Drama and Musical Theatre). Both organisations offer OFQUAL regulated dance tests.

Disco Dancing

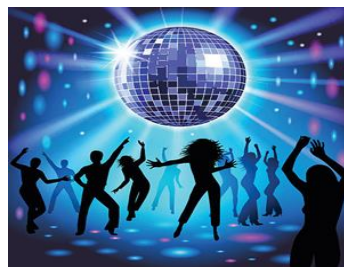
This term the theme is “Outer Space!”

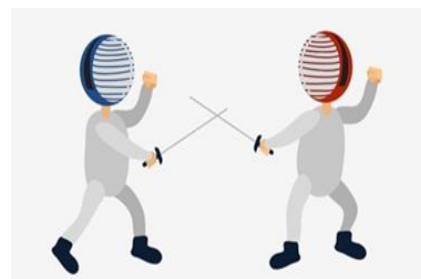


Fencing Club
