## Introduction

This edition of the After-School Clubs booklet reflects changes we have made in the clubs we offer, based on feedback and our desire to bring more and varied opportunities into the programme. Our clubs provision is constantly evolving as we seek fresh and inspiring ways to extend and enrich children's learning and respond dynamically to their interests.

At the heart of our ambition for Blackheath Prep is our commitment to providing the very best for all children to enjoy and achieve. This includes having the widest possible range of opportunities both within and beyond the curriculum. We offer extra-curricular opportunities through various types of provision delivered by school staff, external providers and independent clubs, all with a view to increasing the range of experiences that children have, enabling them to make informed choices for adult life. Activities are designed to be fun and cater for a wide variety of interests.

We want to offer the scope for each and every child to find a passion, develop a talent, spark an interest or simply find pleasure in doing an activity with others. After-school clubs are a fantastic way of achieving this and we are excited to offer a wide range of clubs.

Some internal clubs are heavily oversubscribed every term and children may be placed on a waiting list for these clubs. Clubs may be allocated on rotation to ensure fairness of allocation to all pupils. Whilst every effort is made to ensure that children are able to enjoy their choice of clubs, this is not always possible.

### **Clubs may be cancelled if there are not enough participants.**

We hope you will take time to explore what is on offer and encourage your child to try something new or continue taking part in a firm favourite.

We will be using the online myEVOLVE booking system for all internal clubs, as well as Tennis. Other external club providers have various means of booking which are detailed in this booklet.

**Internally run club preferences can be selected via myEVOLVE on MySchoolPortal.**

**External club bookings will open on Friday 14 March 2025.**

**All club selections must be made by 8pm on Monday 24 March 2025.**

**Club allocations will be made by Monday 31 March 2025.**

**Please note that the clubs run by outside agencies require direct booking and payment to secure your place.** The charge for all internal clubs run by Blackheath Prep staff are charged through the myEVOLVE platform. Occasionally, fixtures and other events will mean that children may miss a club and in these circumstances, **we regret that we are unable to provide a refund.** The PE Department will make every effort to schedule fixtures on allocated Games afternoons to minimise disruption to after-school activities so please do bear this in mind when booking your clubs. Year 4 Games takes place on Tuesday afternoon, Year 3 Games take place on Wednesday afternoon, Year 5 Games takes place on Thursday afternoon and Year 6 Games take place on Friday afternoon.

***The school's Summer term calendar will be available on My School Portal. If you feel that too many sessions of a club are likely to be missed due to other events, you have the option to change or cancel your bookings at the start of the Summer Term. No changes will be accepted once the clubs programme has commenced on Monday 28 April 2025.***

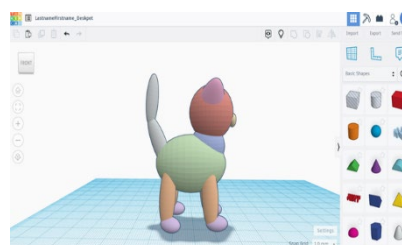

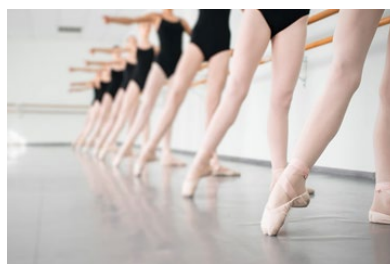
### Ballet

## Code Kids

### Minecraft Coding

Learn to code with the world's most popular block-building game. Coders will learn new programming concepts and mathematics concepts each week with Minecraft Education Edition. They will be given projects that help build problem-solving skills using Microsoft MakeCode (and potentially Python or JavaScript for the older year groups) in a safe, single-player, 3D Minecraft world. Topics will build up each week with co-ordinate geometry, conditionals, loops, variables, functions and much more!

### Lego Robotics and Coding

Build and code your own robots! In this club, the children will learn about all types of components that are used in building robots: processors, motors, sensors, displays etc. They will use these to build and programme their robots, and will be given a set of challenges to complete each week. Applications will vary from smart homes and automated machines to rescue bots and space rovers. The Pre-Prep children will be working with Lego Wedo 2.0 and Lego Spike Essential, while the Prep children will use Lego Spike Prime, BBC Micro:Bit, MakeyMakey, Sphero BOLT etc. **Please note the later finish time for this club of 4.45pm.**

In the class we will explore steps and techniques of different dance styles. We will be linking the different dance genres to make a dance melody, choosing from Disco, Jazz, Street, Ballet, Rock and Roll, Salsa, Theatre, Ballroom and Latin. We will also explore different music and themes to create our end of term show dance. Pupils will experiment with choreography, learning set choreography from the teacher and developing their creativity by adding their own moves. We will add props depending on the chosen topic. Past themes include Summer, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and High School Musical. The club is great at developing team building skills, creativity and confidence. The class content will follow the IDTA and ISTD dance syllabi of the chosen genres. The IDTA and ISTD are recognised awarding organisations of the CDMT (Council of Dance, Drama and Musical Theatre). Both organisations offer OFQUAL regulated dance tests.

Pupils can work towards IDTA and ISTD examinations, Theatre Shows and an end of term demonstration. Each term pupils are presented a certificate outlining the work and learning objectives that we have covered.

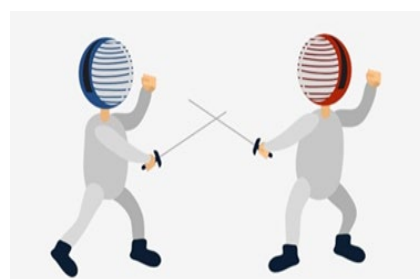
### Fencing Club

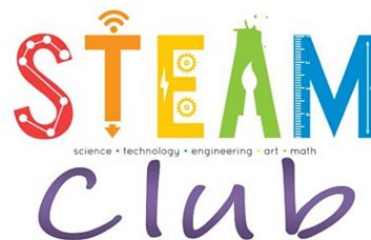
