Introduction

After-school clubs are a fantastic way of helping to achieve this and we are excited to offer a wide range of clubs at Blackheath Prep. We hope you will take time to explore what is on offer and encourage your child to try something new, or continue taking part in a firm favourite.

Our clubs provision is constantly evolving as we seek fresh and inspiring ways to extend and enrich children's learning, and respond dynamically to their interests. Activities are designed to be fun and cater for a wide variety of interests. We offer extra-curricular opportunities through various types of provision, delivered by school staff, external providers and independent clubs, all with a view to increasing the range of experiences that children have.

Club Fees

The cost for internally run clubs is **£11.86** per session. The prices shown are inclusive of VAT. External clubs are charged at variable rates, detailed in this handbook. Advance payment for clubs must be made by **Friday 24 April 2026** to secure your child's space in a club.

Activities in a **blue box** will need to be booked directly with the external provider who have various means of booking which are detailed in this booklet. **Please note that the clubs run by outside agencies require direct booking and payment to secure a place.**

Any changes to bookings must be made by **Monday 27 April 2026**. There will be no refund if a child is withdrawn from a club after clubs have started on **Monday 27 April 2026**.

Place allocations

Whilst every effort is made to ensure that children are able to enjoy their choice of clubs, this is not always possible and selecting a preference for a club does not guarantee a placement in a club. Some internal clubs are heavily oversubscribed every term and children may be placed on a waiting list for these clubs. Clubs may be allocated on rotation to ensure fairness of allocation to all pupils. Club allocations will be made by **Thursday 26 March 2026** and successful applicants will receive a payment link from myEVOLVE to secure the club place. *Clubs may be cancelled if there are not enough participants.*

Games Fixtures

Occasionally, fixtures and other events will mean that children may miss a club and, in these circumstances, **we regret that we are unable to provide a refund.** The PE Department will make every effort to schedule fixtures on allocated Games afternoons to minimise disruption to after-school activities so please do bear this in mind when booking your clubs. Year 4 Games takes place on Tuesday afternoon, Year 3 Games take place on Wednesday afternoon, Year 5 Games takes place on Thursday afternoon, and Year 6 Games take place on Friday afternoon.

The school's term events calendar is available on My School Portal. If you feel that too many sessions of a club are likely to be missed due to other events, you have the option to change or cancel your bookings at the start of the Summer Term. No changes will be accepted once the clubs programme has commenced on Monday 27 April 2026.

Year 6 Pupils

Year 6 pupils should make their club selections as normal. Owing to the potential disruption to the clubs programme due to the children attending after-school rehearsals, Year 6 parents will be charged in arrears for only the dates of internally run clubs attended in the Summer Term. Please contact external providers directly to discuss booking options.

Music Ensembles and Choirs

Our instrumental ensembles are generally for pupils working at, or above, Grade 1 standard on their instrument (with the exception of Pre-Prep Ensemble). Do let us know if your child:

1. Has not played with an ensemble this year
2. Is of the appropriate standard
3. Would like to join next year

Morning Sports Clubs

Morning sports clubs are offered free of charge and will be confirmed at the start of the Summer term. Children will explore set grade exercises from both the ISTD and IDTA syllabi, building strong foundations in posture, coordination, musicality and performance skills.

The ISTD and IDTA are recognised awarding organisations of the CDMT (Council of Dance, Drama and Musical Theatre) and offer OFQUAL regulated examinations.

All learning will be creatively woven together into our special end-of-term demonstration, "On the Seashore." Dancers will bring to life favourite beach memories — enjoying ice cream treats, paddling in the sea and gazing at the horizon.

Pupils will dance to beautiful music, including Offenbach's Barcarolle for our Ice Cream Dance, alongside syllabus music and other seaside-inspired pieces. Children will also enjoy using props such as dance ribbons and scarves to inspire creativity, focus and confident performance.

Pupils may work towards examinations, theatre performances and end-of-term demonstrations. At the end of each term parents will be invited to our presentation and pupils will receive a certificate outlining the skills and learning objectives covered.

Code Kids

Minecraft Coding

Learn to code with the world’s most popular block-building game. Coders will learn new programming concepts and mathematics concepts each week with Minecraft Education Edition. They will be given projects that help build problem-solving skills using Microsoft MakeCode (and potentially Python or JavaScript for the older year groups) in a safe, single-player, 3D Minecraft world. Topics will build up each week with co-ordinate geometry, conditionals, loops, variables, functions and much more!

Lego Robotics and Coding

Build and code your own robots! In this club, the children will learn about all types of components that are used in building robots: processors, motors, sensors, displays etc. They will use these to build and programme their robots, and will be given a set of challenges to complete each week. Applications will vary from smart homes and automated machines to rescue bots and space rovers. The Pre-Prep children will be working with Lego Wedo 2.0 and Lego Spike Essential, while the Prep children will use Lego Spike Prime, BBC Micro:Bit, MakeyMakey, Sphero BOLT etc. **Please note the later finish time for this club of 4.50pm.**

This club introduces Reception pupils to foundational computational thinking through practical, engaging activities. Using ScratchJr and LEGO® WeDo 2.0, children will create simple programs with visual block coding, connecting code to real-world outcomes like movement, sound, and sensor-based reactions.

Children explore key early concepts including sequencing, events, repetition (loops), simple conditionals, and cause-and-effect logic, while developing collaboration, communication, fine motor skills, and resilience.

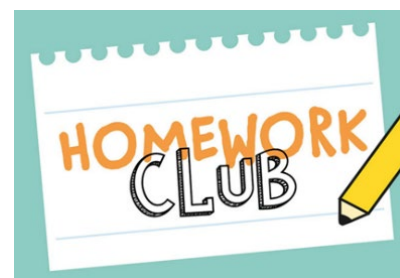

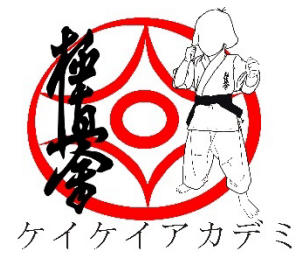
Karate Kyokushin
